AHAA SHOW REGULATIONS (as at April 2009)

1. All horses must be registered with the AHAA or their relevant Breed Association and must comply with their society's rules and regulations.
2. A judge's decision will be final. A judge's decision represents an individual preference and is unable to be protested against, unless it is held to be in violation of a rule.
3. Any person insulting or interfering with the Judges during the Show will be subject to removal from the Show and the prizes (if any) awarded to him/her forfeited.
4. Protests must be lodged with the Show Secretary in writing and signed by the applicant within one (1) hour of the completion of the actual event accompanied with a deposit of \$25 which shall be forfeited to the Association if the protest be considered unfounded or frivolous.
5. In the event of any protest being received the same will be considered as soon as possible by the Show Committee.
6. Approved safety helmets must be worn – Aus/NZ3838 or equivalent to that of the US and Europe:
 - a. at all times by all riders under 18 years of age
 - b. by all riders in warm up areas
 - c. according to EFA rules for ridden classes (i.e. at the discretion of the rider, a helmet, bowler, top hat or costume hat may be worn)
7. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete etc, any or the entire program without prior notice.
8. Any horses not under control or behaving badly may be asked to leave the arena or grounds
9. Age of exhibits to be taken from 1st August. All foals born before 31/12/2010 must be in hand in the ring.
10. Partbred Andalusian Males competing over the age of 2 years and one day must be gelded.
11. Any time except when stabled, entire's must be handled with (a) a bit (b) a combination of a halter & chain or (c) a serretta or any combination of the above.
12. Handlers of entire's must be 18 years or over.
13. At all AHAA run shows, owners are subject to allowing the Steward to check the horse's identification as per those papers, if so requested before entering the ring.
14. The entry forms would include the statement that the Exhibitor has read and understood the Show Rules and Regulations, and if a non-member of a breed Association or EA Association, have signed a "Non member Waiver of Liability" form at the time of entry.
15. No horse may compete under the influence of performance modifying substances at Shows.
16. A whip of any length may be carried in all classes, but a handler may be disqualified for the inappropriate or cruel use of a whip.
17. No horse may be shown in a roller in Led classes.
18. Places in classes shall be up to 3rd place.
19. The wearing of stud logos is not permitted on any item of clothing/saddle cloth while competing in breed classes.
20. Refunds will not be issued without a vet/doctors certificate with written notice prior to the day of the show. Send to show secretary – 10% will be deducted for admin fees

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that whilst participating I wear a suitable helmet at all times where required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue Equestrian Australia and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

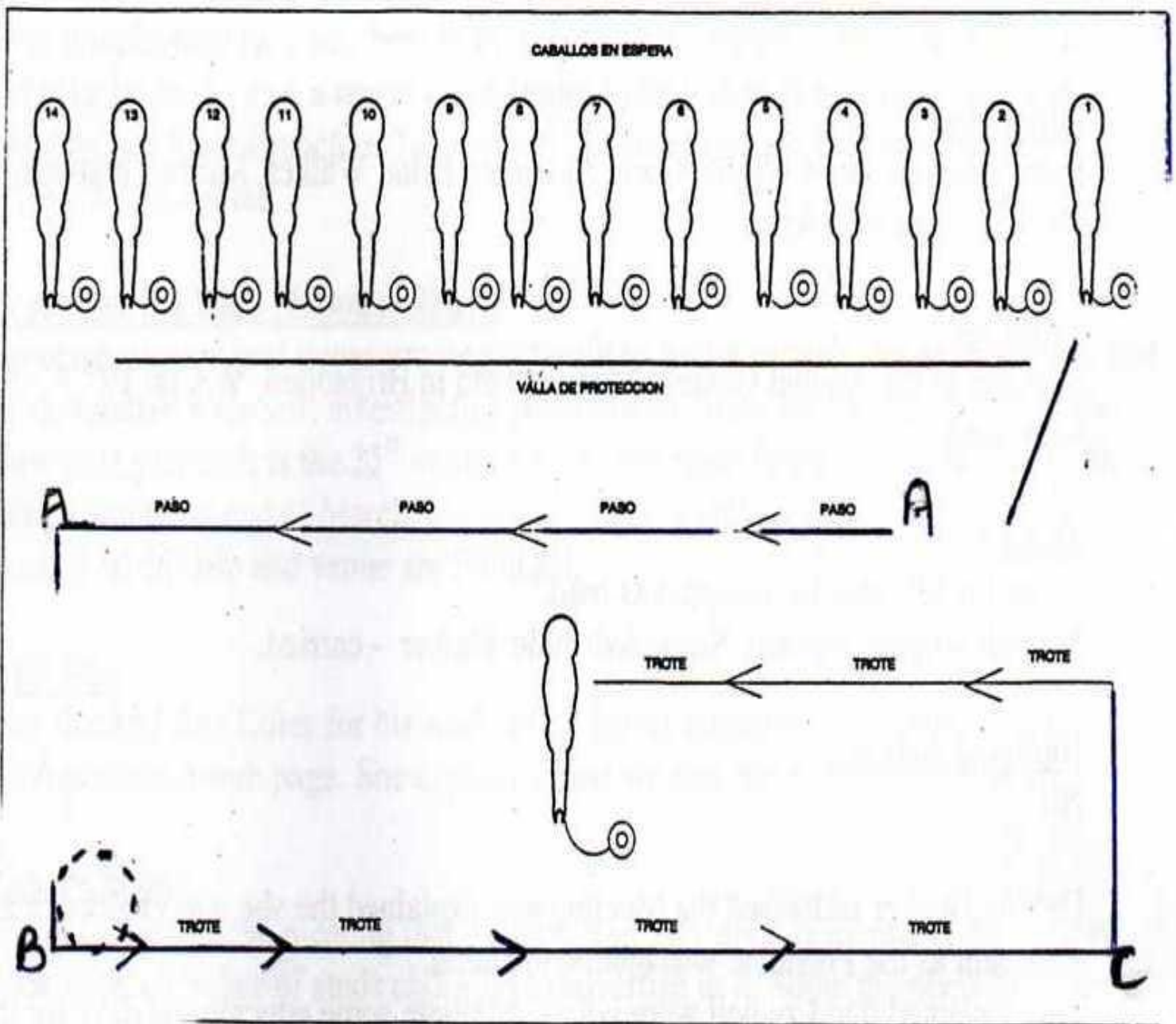
HALTER WORKOUT

The Halter Workout to be used at National and State Championships is being looked on favorably by Judges and Competitors where it has been used.

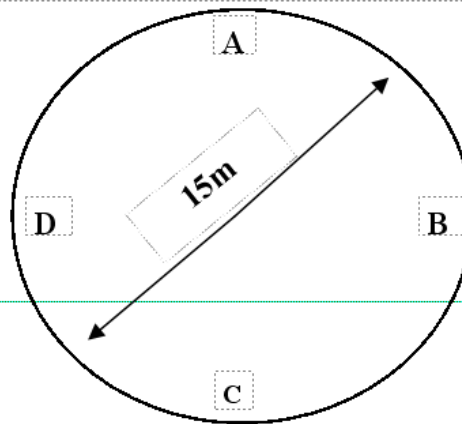
Simply the format is to leave the class line up, present to judge. Walk (Paso) horse to A. Proceed at walk A---B. At "B" lunge horse a maximum of three circles, and on the 3rd circle or before, when your horse is balanced commence trotting (trote) the straight line B---C. The handler should commence running when the horse is at the far point down the line B---C. The handler may choose not to circle at B, but simply to trot freely between B---C on the long lead.

The critical thing about the workout is to allow the horse to show his/her gait freely without the handler unintentionally interfering (e.g. restricting or turning the head of the animal) thus preventing the animal in showing its true movement.

Although this workout is optional and members are able to show with a short lead if they choose



LUNGEING TESTS



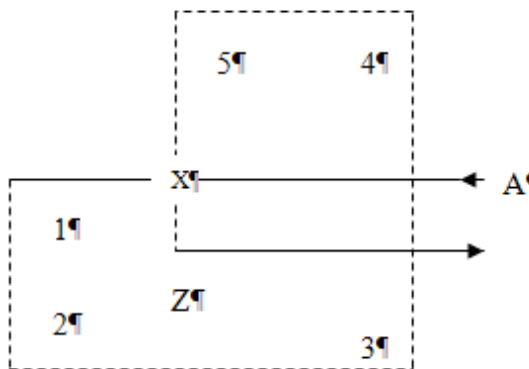
LUNGEING HORSES 4 YRS & UNDER

1. Stand horse on circumference of ring at A. Facing Clockwise. Retire to centre.
2. Walk horse one complete circle plus A-B.
3. Halt at B. Immobility 3 seconds.
4. Walk B-C-D-A
5. Trot at A. one complete circle plus A-B-C.
6. Walk C-D-A.
7. Halt at A. Approach horse & pat on neck while horse remains immobile.
8. Turn horse on circumference of ring at A. to face anti-clockwise. Retire to centre.
9. Walk horse one complete circle plus A-D.
10. Halt at D. immobility for 3 seconds.
11. Walk D-C-B-A
12. Trot at A. one complete circle plus A-D-C.
13. Walk C-B-A. Halt at A. approach horse & pat on neck while horse remains immobile. Lead horse from the arena.

LUNGEING HORSE YRS & OVER

1. Standing horse on circumference of ring at A. facing clockwise. Retire to centre.
2. Walk on complete circle.
3. Halt at B. Immobility for 5 seconds.
4. Walk B-C. trot 2 complete circles.
5. Canter 2 complete circles.
6. C-A. Trot
7. Halt at A. Approach & pat on neck while horse remains immobile.
8. Turn horse on circumference of the ring at A. to face anti-clockwise. Retire to centre.
9. Walk horse one complete circle plus A-D.
10. Halt at D. immobility for 5 seconds.
11. Halt at D-C. Trot at C. 2 complete circles.
12. At C. canter 2 complete circles.
13. C-A. trot
14. Halt at A. Approach horse & pat on neck while horse remains immobile. Lead horse from arena.

HORSE & HANDLER TEST FOR ALL AGES GROUPS



- Solid line: → → → → → indicated at the walk
 Broken line: → → → → → indicated at the trot.
- Commence test at A. Proceed to X. halt & show your horse. Continue when advised by judge.
- Proceed around numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5.
- And halt at Z. Show your horse.
- On advice from judge leave arena.
