Trail riding on my Andalusians for charity

Having owned andalusians for 22 years and having been a volunteer and coach with RDAV for some 15 of those years it seemed only normal that I use my horses to raise money to help people with a disability.

The first trail ride was organized in 1995 to raise money for Yooralla. Manuka Mandato (Dato) was my mount – the ride being from Colac to Aireys Inlet – fancy dress was a Baby Boomer. The second ride was Rutherglen to Myrtleford on Dato with fancy dress – Fairy on a Unicorn. The third ride started and finished in Castlemaine with fancy dress as a Nun. The next ride was to raise money for RDAV and Andaluka Montego II (Monty) was my mount for the next seven rides. The first starting and finishing at Malmsbury – a Soldier was fancy dress. The next ride starting and finishing at Daylesford – fancy dress was an Astronaut. The third ride was from Bruthen to Buchan – Maid Marion being fancy dress. Next ride in the Yakandandra – Stanley area with fancy dress – an Easter Bunny. Trentham area was the next ride – fancy dress a Glitter Sister. In 2005 we rode in the Licola area – fancy dress Abba. Next back to the Trentham area – Dame Edna fancy dress. For the 2007 ride Diestro Estrello

(Starski) was my mount. Fancy dress had ceased and the ride was around the Clonbinane area. Starski did the next Trentham ride and the last ride in the Riddells Creek area.

The rides have all been over 100 kms in length run over 5 days with a rest day in the middle. In earlier rides we shifted camp each day we rode – riding to a new camp site we would have to establish a new camp and pack up the next day for the move again. By the end of the ride you were either completely exhausted or felt like super woman. Always though so happy with what you had achieved with your horse. I have thoroughly enjoyed all rides on my andys and have raised over \$20,000 for a great cause. The proceeds coming from generous friends and business acquaintances. I can highly recommend these rides to anyone wanting to have a holiday with their horse and you met **many** other riders while raising money at the same time.

- 1 The committee has had to impose a \$20 levy per entry (per family/stud etc) to help with the costs of running the show. 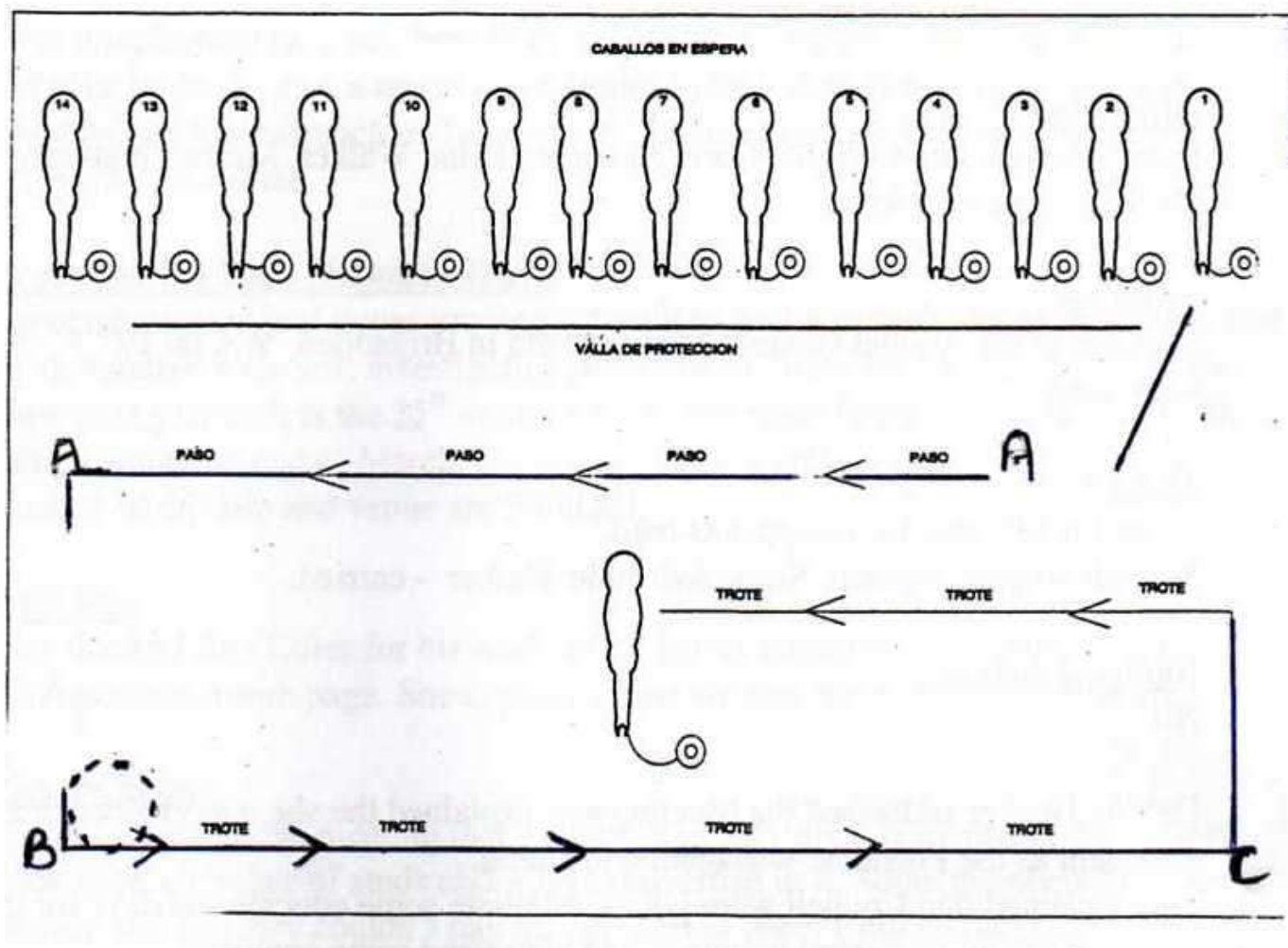
HALTER WORKOUT

The Halter Workout to be used at National and State Championships is being looked on favourably by Judges and Competitors where it has been used.

Simply the format is to leave the class line up, present to judge. Walk (Paso) horse to A. Proceed at walk A---B. At "B" lunge horse a maximum of three circles, and on the 3rd circle or before, when your horse is balanced commence trotting (trote) the straight line B---C. The handler should commence running when the horse is at the far point down the line B---C. The handler may choose not to circle at B, but simply to trot freely between B---C on the long lead.

The critical thing about the workout is to allow the horse to show his/her gait freely without the handler unintentionally interfering (e.g. restricting or turning the head of the animal) thus preventing the animal in showing its true movement.

Although this workout is optional and members are able to show with a short lead if they choose
